About Pledges

1. A Pledge is a commitment to pay a specific sum over a defined period of years, with payments made monthly, quarterly or annually. The value of a Pledge to The BRIT School Foundation is that it enables us to plan future income to The BRIT Silver Campaign with a high degree of certainty, unlike regular Gift Aid payments which can be cancelled at any time.
2. As the School has exempt charity status all donations can be made under Gift Aid, provided the donor is in a position to sign the Gift Aid declaration in the Pledge form.
3. If you pay income tax at the higher or additional rate you can claim the difference between the higher and basic rate on your donation. To receive the additional tax relief you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue & Customs to adjust your tax code.
